Policies and Procedures

Dallas Stars Boy Scout Sleepover

- **Is there a badge or patch for participating in the sleepover?** Each Scout will receive a patch and a t-shirt for participating in the sleepover. Merit badges and other achievement awards will be coordinated through your Pack or Troop.
- **What food / beverage options are available?** Concession stands will be open from 6:00 - Midnight on Friday for purchase of stadium food / beverage. A breakfast snack (bananas, apples, oranges, granola bars) will be provided at no additional cost.
- **Extra Money?** They will need extra money for the concessions, merchandise, etc.
- **What is included in the price?** The ticket for the Stars game, sleepover, movie on the HD video board, tour of Press Box, able to watch arena changeover from hockey to basketball, post-game rally and a breakfast snack in the morning
- **Where will the Scouts be sleeping?** The Scouts will be sleeping on concourses in suite levels, inside arena
- **What kind of sleeping equipment will be provided and what kind do they need?** They will need to bring a pillow and sleeping bag, roll out foam mattress if you would like. No bedding or cots will be provided.
- **What ages of Scouts will be sleeping over?** Anyone currently a member in Scouting is eligible to participate
- **What ages groups will be sleeping in same area?** Troops and Packs will be paired separately
- **What is the adult-to-scout ratio for this event?** Please refer to the Boy Scout guidelines on appropriate adult-to-scout ratios based on the ages of your scouts.
- **Can a parent attend and sleep over with his / her Scout?** Yes, parents are welcome to join the sleep over with their son's Pack / Troop. They do need to register and pay in advance like the Scouts.
- **What is the refund policy?** Refunds will not be granted unless the game is not played.
- **Do they need jackets for the sleepover and the game?** Please have the Scouts dress appropriately for sleeping in an ice rink - it will be cool during the game and cool / cold overnight. Depending on the temperature outside, the arena temperature will stay between 68-70 degrees.
- **Where do we drop them off and meet them for pick-up?** Please coordinate that with your Pack / Troop leaders. There is NO drop off / pick-up at American Airlines Center - each scout must come with a parent, guardian or Scout Leader.
- **What time does check-in begin?** Check in begins at 5:00 p.m. and ends at 7:15 p.m. Check-in will occur on the AT&T Plaza on the south side of American Airlines Center. Look for the Southern Painting trucks - the check-in table will be right in front of the trucks.
- **Where do we park and how much is it?** Parking is available in any of the cash lots around the arena. Most are located on the south and southeast sides of the arena, and will cost between \$10-\$20 per vehicle depending on the lot. Bus parking is available for \$30 per bus in Lot C by Woodall Rogers, or in the West End.
- **Where do the Scouts store their gear during the game?** The scouts will store their gear in Southern Painting trailers located at check-in on AT&T Plaza. They will be able to pick up their gear immediately after the game at the post-game rally

- **Do they need cameras?** Still photography is allowed in the arena, so we encourage all Packs / Troops to have at least one camera with them. Each Pack / Troop will have the opportunity to take pictures of the movie, rally, changeover and Press Box, but **YOU NEED TO PROVIDE YOUR OWN CAMERA**. No video cameras are allowed in American Airlines Center during the Stars game, so we encourage everybody to leave these at home.
- **How do I reach my child during the game?** American Airlines Security can be reached at 214.665.4825. They can contact the Stars and Scout representatives to get a message to your child. Also, cell phones are allowed in case you'd like to provide your child with one.
- **Where do the Dallas Stars play?** Stars games are played at American Airlines Center at 2500 Victory Ave. Dallas TX, 75219
- **Illness / Injury?** If a child or adult becomes ill or is injured, the contact on his / her medical release form will be notified. No oral medicines or first aid will be administered except by the child's chaperone, if necessary. A basic first aid kit will be available. For any matter involving medical treatment or otherwise, the Museum of Nature and Science disallows all responsibility for the cost of this or any other medical treatment.
- **Behavior / Conduct?** Scout leaders are responsible for the behavior of the Scouts. Each Scout should be accompanied by a chaperone. All Scouts are to stay inside the designated area during the sleepover.
- **Special needs?** Special needs for any person should be coordinated through the Sleepover Coordinator.
